



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® Bitty Stripes™ (10 oz/283 g; 515 yds/471 m)

Main Color (MC) Rattan (0103) **1 ball or 200 yds/183 m**

Red Heart® Super Saver™ Super Craft Kit™ – 1 kit

Kit includes 12 balls (50 g/1.7 oz each; 600 g/21 oz total), yardage (85 m/93 yds each; 1020 m/1116 yds total).

Contrast A Pumpkin **1 ball or 12 yds/11 m**

Contrast B Saffron **1 ball or 8 yds/7.5 m**

Contrast C Cherry Red **1 ball or 8 yds/7.5 m**

Contrast D Café Latte **1 ball or 6 yds/5.5 m**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® stitch marker. 1 pipe cleaner to support Tail.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit 23" [58.5 cm] tall porch goose with head circumference of 9" [23 cm] and body circumference of 26" [66 cm].

GAUGES

12 sc and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

12 dc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

PONCHO

Notes:

- Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc.
- Ch 4 at beg of rnd counts as dc and ch-1 sp.

- Ch 6 at beg of rnd counts as dc and ch-3 sp.
- Join all rnds with sl st to 3rd ch, unless otherwise stated.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook of previous color. Yoh with new color, draw through loop and proceed with new color.

With MC, ch 28. Join with sl st to first ch, taking care not to twist chain. *See diagram on page 3.*

1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join with sl st to first sc. 28 sc.

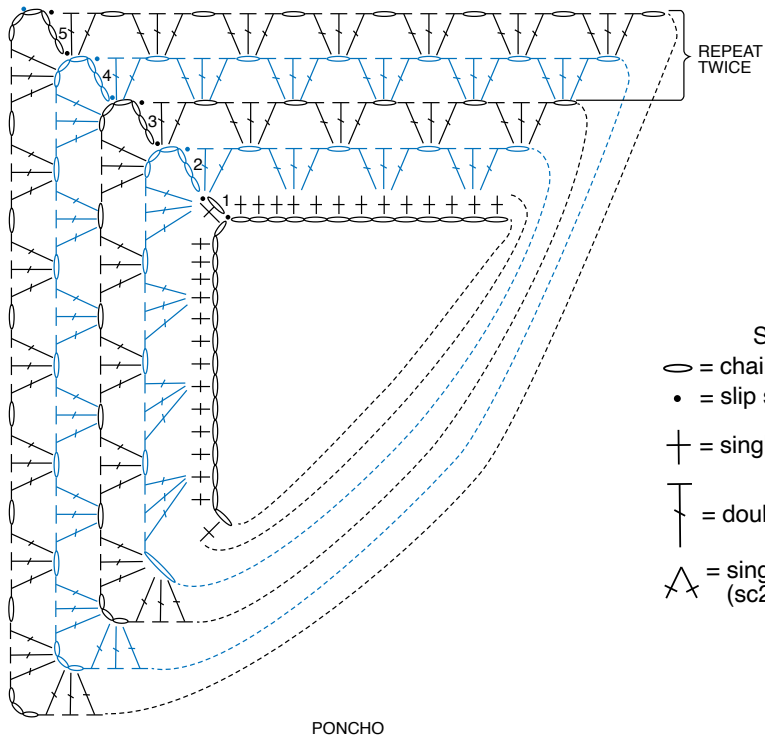
2nd rnd: Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as sl st. **Note:** Ch-3 sp just made will be front of Poncho. Ch 1. *Skip next 3 sc. 3 dc in next sc – cluster made. Ch 1. Rep from * 5 times more. Skip last 3 sc. 2 dc in same sp as sl st. Join. 8 clusters and 1 ch-3 sp.

3rd rnd: Sl st in ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as sl st. Ch 1. *3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1.** Rep from * twice more. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) all in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to ** 3 times more. 2 dc in same sp as sl st. Join. 10 clusters and 2 ch-3 sps.

4th rnd: Sl st in ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as sl st. Ch 1. *3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to next ch-3 sp.** (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to ** once more. 2 dc in same sp as sl st. Join. 12 clusters and 2 ch-3 sps.

5th rnd: Sl st in ch-3 sp. Ch 6. 3 dc in same sp as sl st. Ch 1. *3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to next ch-3 sp.** (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to ** once more. 2 dc in same sp as sl st. Join. 14 clusters and 2 ch-3 sps.

6th to 9th rnds: Rep 4th and 5th rnds twice more. 22 clusters and 2 ch-3 sps at end of 9th rnd.

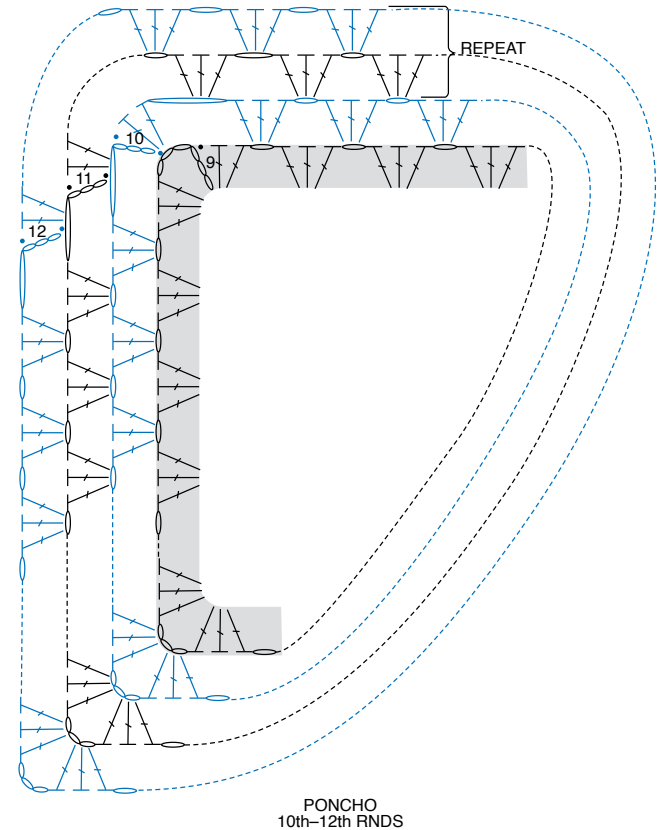


STITCH KEY

- Λ = single crochet 2 together (sc2tog)

10th rnd: Sl st in ch-3 sp. Ch 4. *3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1.** Rep from * to next ch-3 sp. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to ** to end of rnd. 2 dc in same sp as sl st. Join. 23 clusters and 1 ch-3 sp.

11th to 14th rnds: Sl st in first ch-1 sp. Ch 4. *3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1.** Rep from * to next ch-3 sp. (3 dc. Ch 3. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to ** to end of rnd. 2 dc in same sp as sl st. Join. 27 clusters and 1 ch-3 sp at end of 14th rnd. Fasten off at end of 14th rnd.



Wings (Make 2).

With MC, leaving a long yarn end for sewing, ch 4.

1st row: (RS). 3 dc in 4th ch from hook. Turn. 4 dc.

2nd to 4th rows: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each dc to last dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn. 10 dc at end of 4th row.

5th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 1 sc in next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 2 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 1 sc in next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 2 sc in last dc. Join D. Break MC. Turn. 14 sts.

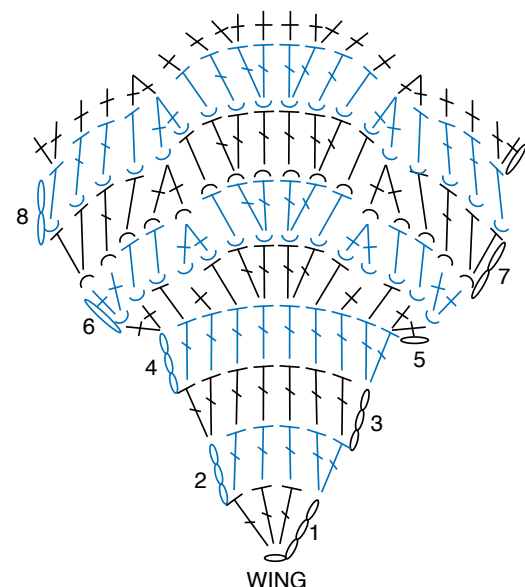
6th row: With D, ch 1. *Working in front loops only*, 2 sc in first st. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. Sc2tog. 1 hdc in next st. 2 dc in each of next 2 sts. 1 hdc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. 2 sc in last st. Join B. Break D. Turn. 16 sts.

7th row: With B, ch 2. *Working in back loops only*, 2 hdc in first st. 1 dc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 hdc in next st. 2 dc in next st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 2 dc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 hdc in next st. 1 dc in next st. 2 hdc in last st. Join A. Break B. Turn. 18 sts.

8th row: With A, ch 2. *Working in front loops only*, 1 hdc in first st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 1 hdc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 hdc in next st. 1 dc in next st. 2 dc in each of next 2 sts. 1 dc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 hdc in next st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 18 sts.

9th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Sc2tog. (1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 2 sc in next st) twice. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 2 sc in last st. 20 sts.

Fasten off.

Tail

With MC, leaving a long yarn end for sewing, ch 4.

1st row: (RS). 7 dc in 4th ch from hook. Turn. 8 dc.

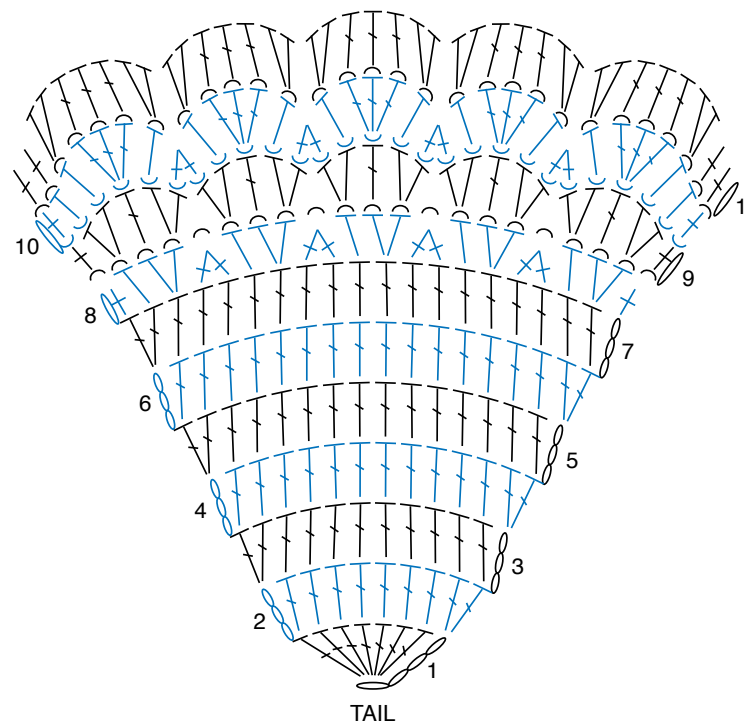
2nd to 7th rows: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each dc to last dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn. 20 dc at end of 7th row.

8th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. (1 hdc in next dc. 2 hdc in next dc. Sc2tog) 4 times. 1 hdc in next dc. 2 hdc in next dc. 1 sc in last dc. Join D. Break MC. Turn. 21 sts.

9th row: With D, ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in first st. (2 hdc in next st. 1 dc in next st. 2 hdc in next st. Skip next st) 4 times. 2 hdc in next st. 1 dc in next st. 2 hdc in next st. 1 sc in last st. Join B. Break D. Turn. 27 sts.

10th row: With B, ch 1. *Working in front loops only*, 1 sc in first sc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. (3 dc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 hdc in next st) 4 times. 3 dc in next st. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. 1 sc in last st. Join A. Break B. Turn. 33 sts.

11th row: With A, ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each of first 2 sts. (2 hdc in next st. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. 2 hdc in next st. Skip next st) 4 times. 2 hdc in next st. 1 dc in each of next 3 sts. 2 hdc in next st. 1 sc in each of last 2 sts. 39 sts. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold pipe cleaner in V-shape so it aligns with both edges of first 7 rows of Tail. With RS facing, join MC with sl st where end of pipe cleaner lands. Ch 1. Work sc evenly down edge of Tail to opposite end of pipe cleaner, working over pipe cleaner to encase it. Fasten off.

Using long tail and yarn needle, sew Tail to back of Poncho with RS tog, aligning point of Tail with ch-3 sp in last rnd of Poncho.

Bend pipe cleaner so Tail sits upright.

Using long yarn ends and yarn needle, sew Wings to either side of Poncho, as shown.

HOOD

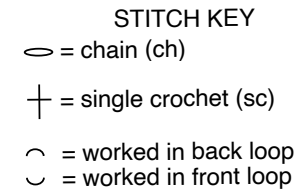
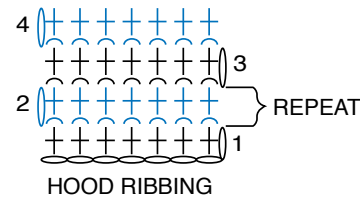
Ribbing: With MC, ch 8.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 7 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures 7" [18 cm], when slightly stretched. **Do not** fasten off.

Joining row: Ch 1. With first and last rows tog, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each st to end of row. **Do not** turn.



Cont for Hood as follows:

Notes:

- Turn at end of each rnd.
- Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.

1st rnd: (RS). Ch 1. Working across long side of Ribbing, work 24 sc evenly around. Join. Turn.

2nd rnd: (WS). Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. Turn. 26 sc.

3rd rnd: (RS). Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 12 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. Turn. 28 sc.

4th rnd: (WS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Turn.

5th rnd: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 5 sc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sc. 1 dc in each of next 10 sc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sc. 1 sc in each of last 5 sc. Join. Turn.

6th rnd: (WS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 5 sts. 1 dc in each of next 12 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 5 sts. 1 sc in each of last 3 sts. Join. Turn.

PM in last st worked for Wattle.

Divide for Face Opening:

1st row: (RS). Sl st in each of first 2 sts. Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts. 1 dc in each of next 12 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

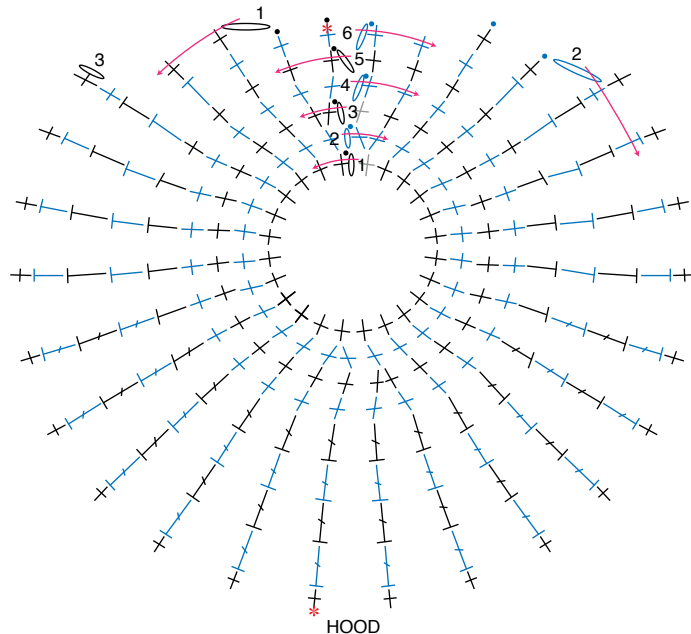
Cont on these 24 sts in rows:

2nd row: Sl st in each of first 2 sts. Ch 1. 1 sc in next st. 1 hdc in each of next 3 sts. 1 dc in each of next 12 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 3 sts. 1 sc in next st. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

Cont on these 20 sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 10 sts. PM for Snood. 1 sc in each st to end of row.

Fasten off.



Wattle

Join C with sl st at Wattle marker. Ch 3. Join into ring with sl st in same sp as first sl st.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 4 sc in ring. Join.

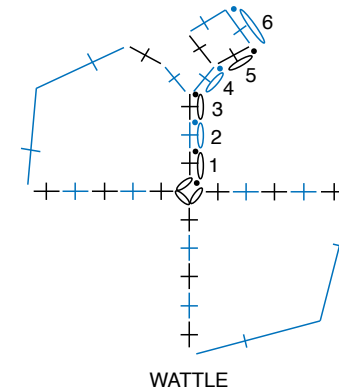
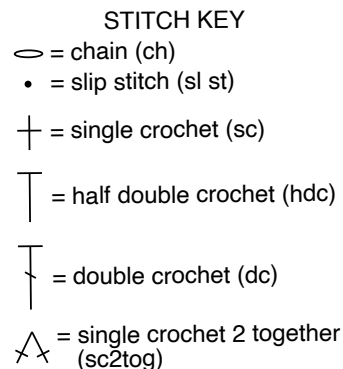
2nd and 3rd rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

4th and 5th rnds: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 6 sc at end of 5th rnd.

6th rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) 3 times. Join.

Fasten off, leaving long yarn end.

Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely.



Snood

With RS facing, join C with sl st at Snood marker.

1st row: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next sc. Turn. 2 sc.

2nd to 6th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

7th row: Ch 1. Skip first sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn.

8th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

9th to 11th rows: Rep 7th and 8th rows once, then 7th row once more.

Fasten off.
